Dear Mr. Wilson:

I am sending this letter in compliance with WAC 180-86-110 and WAC 180-87-095. On the basis of information I have, it appears that Mr. Gary Millard, certificate #278776J, has committed acts of unprofessional conduct as delineated in WAC 180-87, Sexual Misconduct With Students. While Mr. Millard is not presently an employee of the Lake Washington School District, he was employed here from 1987 through 1994. The act of unprofessional practice which he is alleged to have committed occurred while he was a certificated teacher at Lake Washington School District. I understand he is currently employed at the Eastmont School District.

I have received a report that Mr. Millard allegedly had sexual contact with a female student at Juanita High School in his classroom in approximately 1987 or 1988. This allegation has been reported to the \_\_\_\_\_ Police Department,


The Lake Washington School District is not conducting an investigation of this matter because Mr. Millard is no longer employed here. However, as stated above, the district has reported it to the Kirkland Police Department so that they may proceed with an investigation. I do not know the name of the alleged victim nor the date of the alleged occurrence nor the specific sexual conduct.

I am reporting this matter to your office so that you can review it to determine whether Mr. Millard is guilty of any violation of the Code of Professional Conduct,

Chapter 180-87 WAC. The school district will cooperate with your office should you determine that an investigation is warranted.

Please call me if I can be of further assistance. Additionally, I wish to formally request that you send me any proposed or final order that may be entered as a result of this complaint.
