On 05-15-96, at approximately 1650 hours, Reid Stevens of the Lake Washington School District, contacted me at the Kirkland Police Department to report an incident involving a former teacher. Mr. Stevens stated that a current student of Juanita High School had contacted Juanita Principal Sue Cohn and reported a sensitive issue involving a former teacher named Gary Millard. The student relayed that over the past week-end(05-11 or 05-12-96) he attended a card game with some friends. During this party/card game, a person identified as Pat Fagen said that in 1988 or 1989 a former teacher/track coach named Gary Millard had sexual intercourse with a female student/track team member in his Juanita class room. Fagen said that Millard had relayed this information to his minister/marriage counselor Ky Griffin during a marriage counseling session a couple of years after the incident had occurred. Fagen did not mention the female student's name and it was unknown at the time of the report.

Stevens advised that Sue Cohn had contacted Fagen and attempted to confirm the information and obtain the female student's name. Fagen would not confirm or deny the report and requested that she contact Ky Griffin. No contact with Griffin was attempted.


On 05-22-96, Stevens called me and reported that Cohn had discovered the name of the female student. Stevens identified her as

He went on to state that graduated in June of 1990 and would have been 17 years old when the alleged incident occurred. (Note, I checked through the local Kirkland contact system and her home address was listed as

Earlier on 05-16-96, I contacted the King County Prosecutor's office in reference to this investigation and specifically the statute of limitations. I spoke to Deputy Prosecutor Robert Knief of the Special Assault Unit. He advised that if the victim in this case were 14 years old or less at the time of the incident, then the statute would still be open. Knief added that if the female student were 14 years or older then the statute of limitations would be closed.

Once I discovered that the female student was 17 years old at the time of the alleged incident, I explained to Stevens that the statute of limitations had expired. Due to this, we could not investigate the case any further.

On 05-22-96, Stevens contacted me and advised that Lake Washington School District Superintendent Ron Barnes relayed the alleged allegation to Dr. Walt Bigby, the Eastmont School District Superintendent. Stevens said this was done out of professional courtesy and that no follow up actions through the School Districts were planned.
