**AGREED ORDER OF  
STAYED SUSPENSION**

COMES NOW the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and having reviewed the files of the above-referenced case, and having considered the arguments of each party and the recommendation of the Admissions and Professional Conduct Advisory Committee, does hereby stay the suspension of the education certificate of Rueben Alfredo Rojas, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Rueben Alfredo Rojas was issued Washington education certificate No. 235646G on September 4, 1979. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Mr. Rojas was employed by the Highline School District during the 1995-96 school year.
3. On December 8, 1995, the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Highline School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Mr. Rojas.
4. On several different occasions between 1994 and 1996, Mr. Rojas made inappropriate comments to students and acted inappropriately toward students.
