He made himself readily available to all; leaders and followers, soldiers and families. He kept the commander apprised of appropriate issues in a very timely, informative manner. He never brought up an issue or concern without also being able to offer viable solutions to the situation. Chaplain Yee should continue his military education and then work at the brigade or division level ministry operations.
